MyCareNet is the Belgian eHealth platform that enables the secure exchange of electronic medical documents between doctors and health insurers.

This leaflet is addressed to JSIS affiliates, as well as their spouse/partner and children who possess a Belgian Social Security Identification Number (NISS/BIS/National Register) and benefit from primary cover under JSIS.

Through the integration of the Joint Sickness Insurance Scheme (JSIS) with MyCareNet, there is **no need to submit reimbursement** requests for general practitioners' and specialists' consultations. The doctor will issue an eAttest that will be transmitted directly to JSIS in a secure way and within a few minutes.

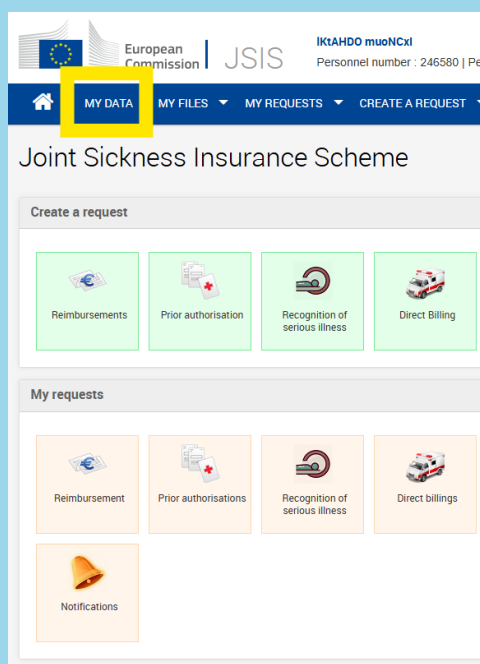
You can register either via **JSIS Online** or via **MyPMO** (see page 5). The screenshots below will guide you through the use of these two applications. Choose the application you prefer to register with and follow the instructions.

How to register via **JSIS Online** ?

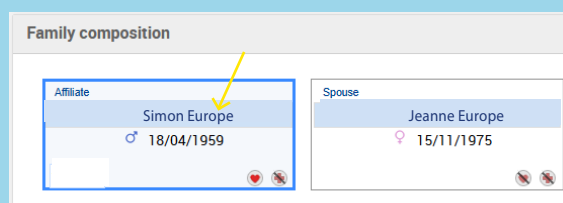
For yourself and your children under 18.

Log in to **JSIS Online**.

On JSIS Online, click on My Data on the top left menu.



Select your profile and click on **“Add national number”** at the bottom right.




How to register via MyPMO?

For yourself and your children under 18.

Click on the top left menu, select **"My Health"** menu and click on **"Administrative data & National number"**.



Select your profile and click on **"Add national number"** at the bottom right.




ADD NATIONAL NUMBER

Tick the **5 boxes** to mark your consent in relation to the processing of your personal data.

Then enter your national number and your children's numbers **no spaces, dots or dashes**.

Click **"Save"**. Registration will be effective as of the next day.

Select your spouse/partner or your children profile.



Download and fill in **the consent form** in relation to the processing of their personal data.

Click on **“Add national number”** at the bottom right.

Enter your spouse's/partner's or your 18+ children numbers **no spaces, dots or dashes**.

Upload the consent form by clicking the **“Select file”** button, or scan it directly using your device's camera by clicking **“Scan Document”**.

Click **“Save”**. Registration will be effective as of the next day.

How does it work?

1. Register

2. At the doctor's

At the start of the consultation, tell your doctor he can issue an eAttest. You pay for the consultation as usual.

3. The eAttest is sent automatically to JSIS

If your doctor does not use a compatible software, you must submit your reimbursement claim the usual way.

4. Receipt

After payment, the doctor may give you a receipt showing the Inami codes, the amounts and supplements. Keep it as proof of payment, but do not submit a reimbursement request based on this receipt.

5. Processing by JSIS

The eAttest automatically creates a reimbursement request in JSIS.

6. Track your claim

You can follow the status:

- on **MyPMO**: My Health >>Reimbursement Requests >>
- or on **JSIS Online**: My Requests >> My Reimbursement requests

What are the benefits of MyCareNet?

- No need to submit claims yourself
- Less paperwork
- No risk of losing documents
- No risk of missing the 18-month deadline
